Facility Services Updates

The new Dog Park is being installed adjacent to The Gables. New fencing was recently installed. Next steps include miscellaneous sod replacement and paver installation. Benches and chairs have been ordered. We anticipate completion in several weeks.

A painting and carpet replacement project will begin in Avalon on Monday, June 7. Painting will begin on Avalon Fourth Floor. Carpet installation is scheduled to begin on Monday, June 14. Work will then progress to the other floors of Avalon. We anticipate completion in late July.

Power washing has begun for the Courtyard Apartments and will then progress to Avalon and Homes on the Green. Following the completion of power washing, annual window washing is anticipated to begin in July. Housekeeping will provide further information regarding the window washing schedule.

Democratic Primary Election – Tuesday, June 8, 2021

All Henrico County Voters residing at Westminster Canterbury may vote from 6 a.m.-7 p.m. in the Cochrane Commons on Tuesday, June 8. Richmond City residents residing in select Homes on the Green and The Glebe must vote at their assigned location off campus. This election is the Democratic Primary. There will be no Republican candidates on the ballot.

All Virginia voters are required to show photo identification. Voters arriving to the polls without an acceptable form of photo ID will be offered a provisional ballot. You will then have until noon on Friday, June 11 to submit a copy of photo identification to your locality's electoral board for the provisional ballot to be counted. Additional written instructions will be provided by the election officials when the provisional ballot is completed.
